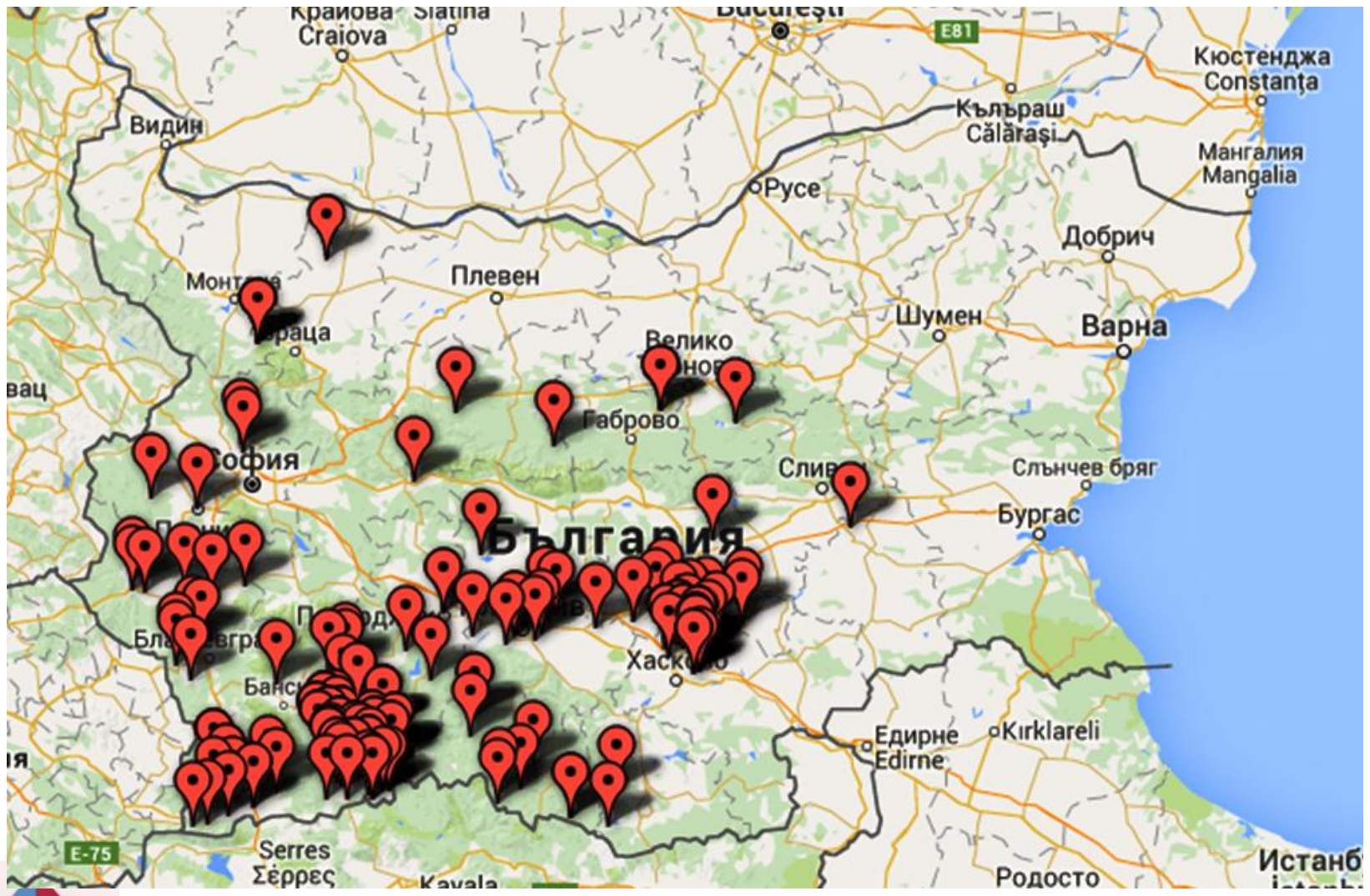

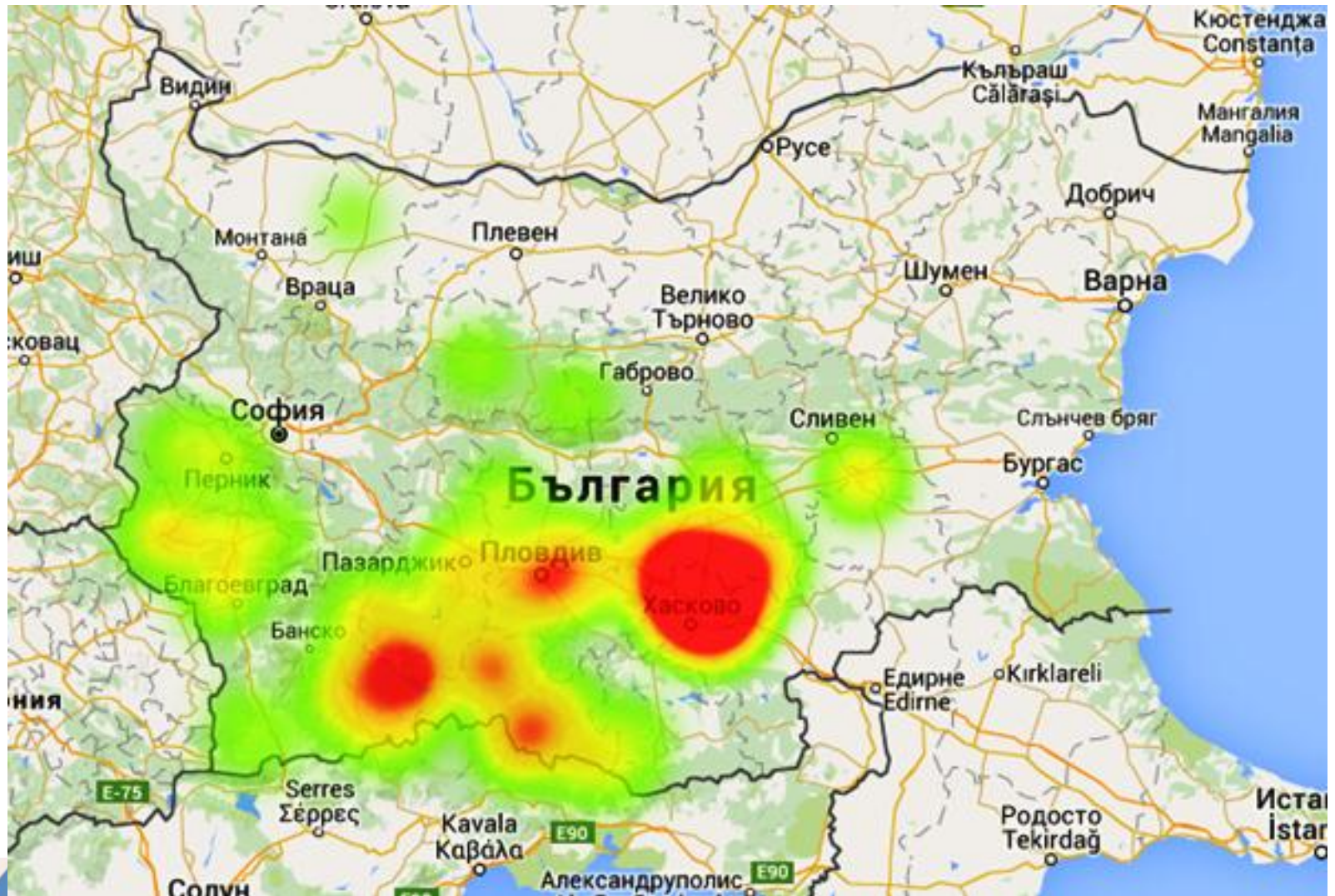

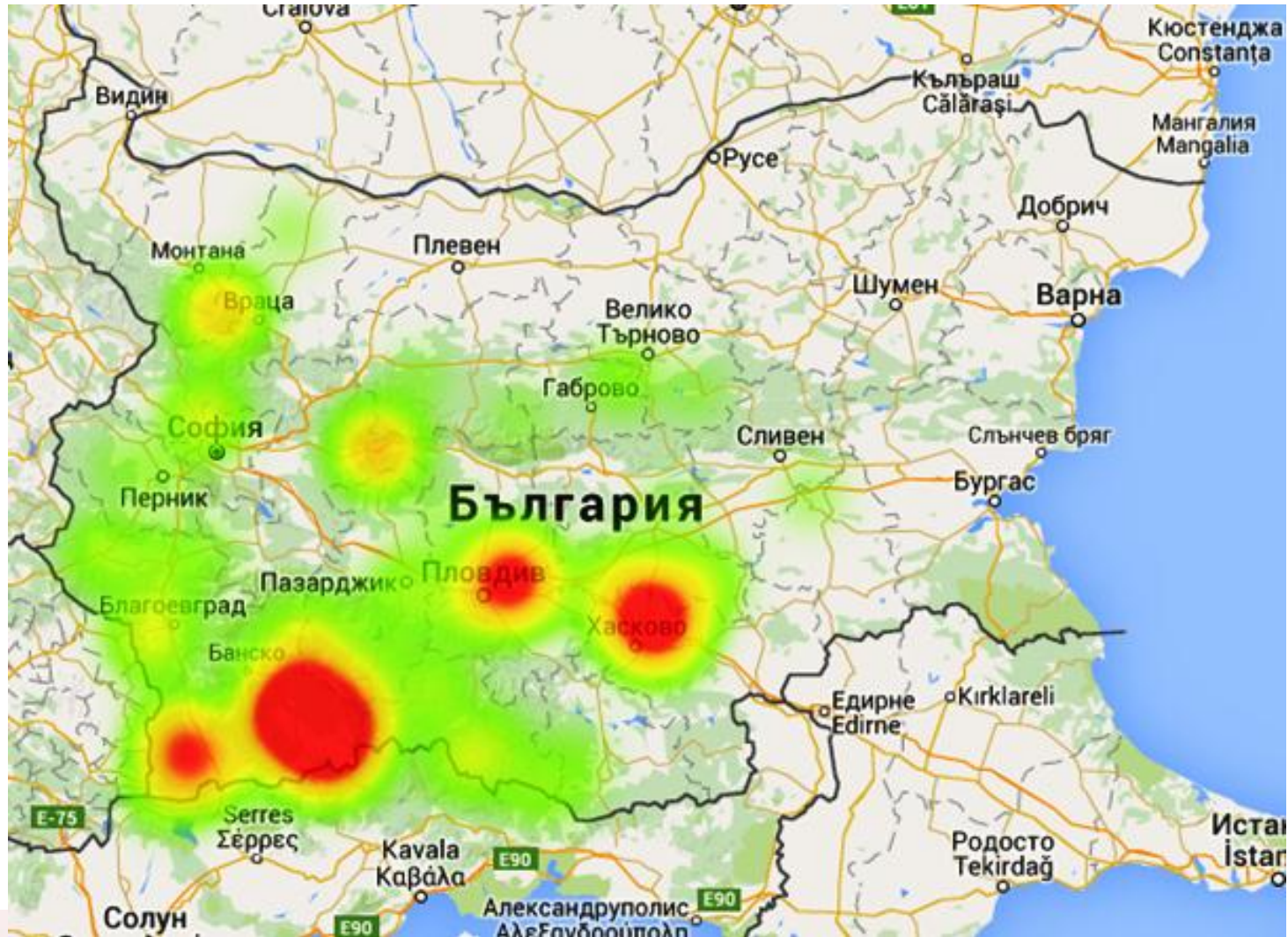

## National LSD situation - % inf. regions



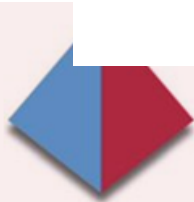
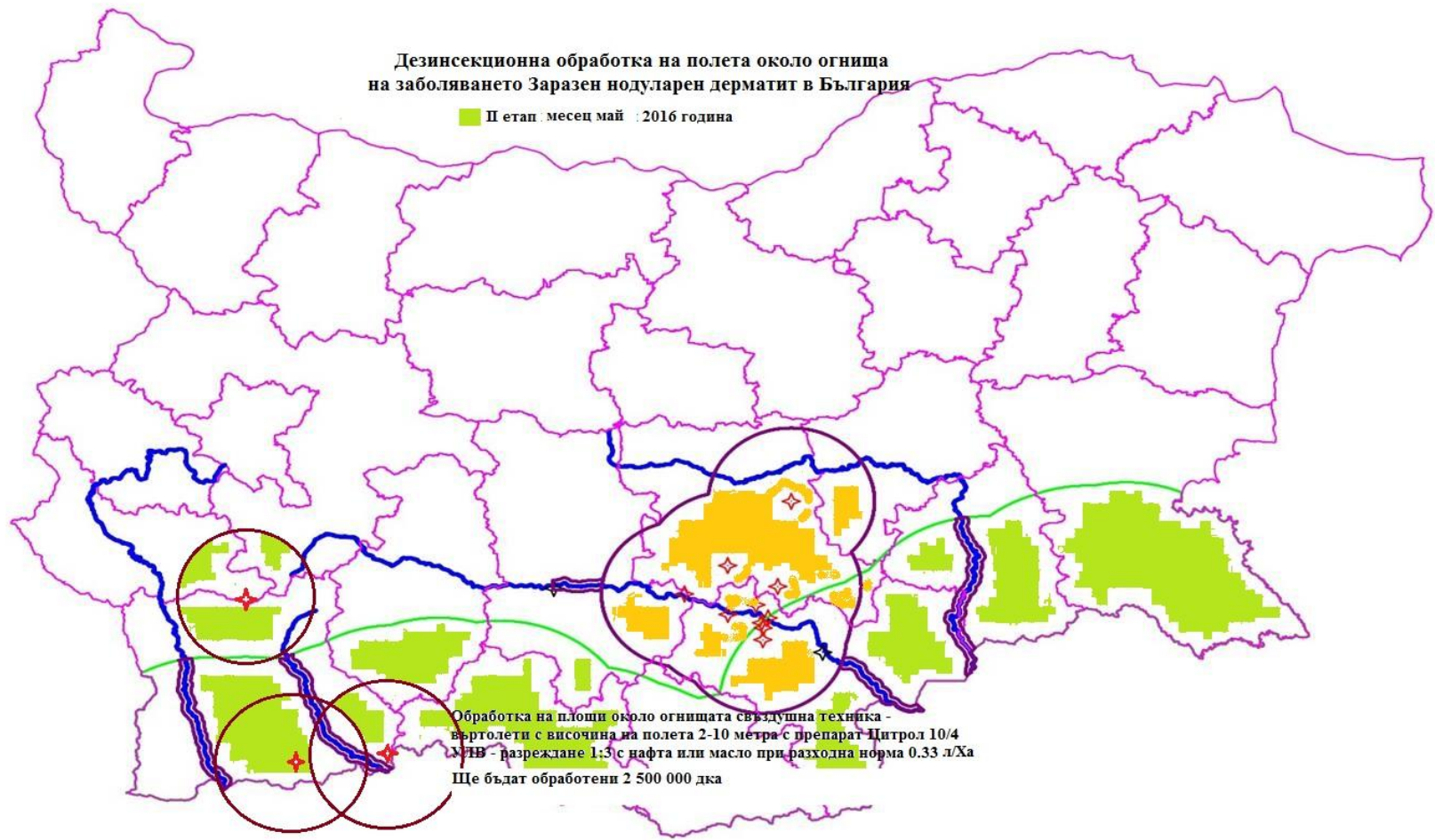

# National LSD situation - % inf. animals

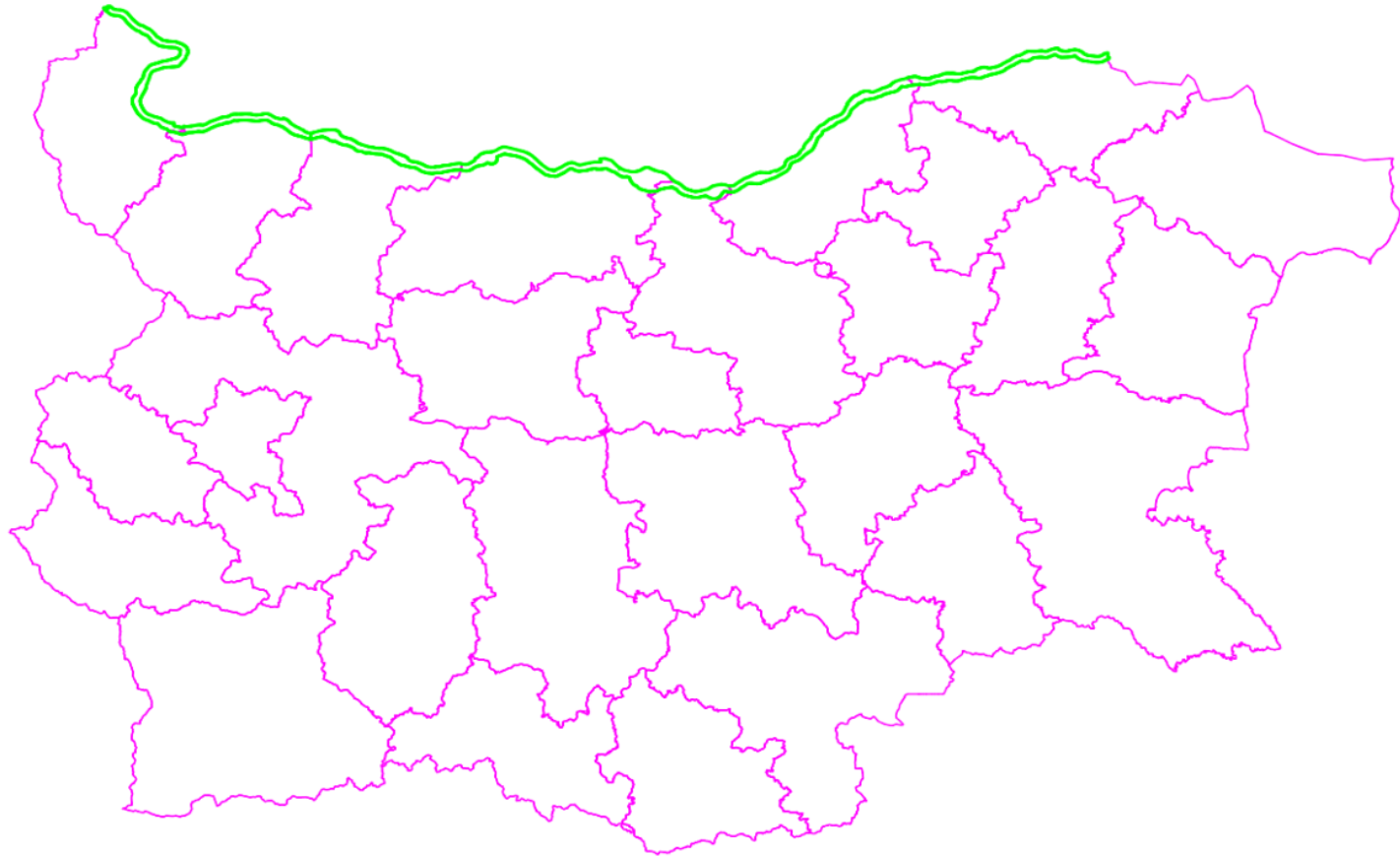

# 'Enabling environment' in place

- Legal basis in place – L92/119, Dec. 645
- LSD Contingency Plan? – Yes
- Organisation of VS ('national LSD Committee?') – HQ of BFSA
- Collaboration with other stakeholders – Bovine associations, Milk factory associations, Beekeepers, AW organizations (according animal export to Turkey)
- Emergency budget 14,5 million BGN ~ € 7,3 millions
- Laboratory capacity (serology/PCR/ Other) – only PCR





# Control measures in place

- Stamping out (total/partial/none) – Total, not modified
- Vaccination (type; N° of doses available/requested)
  - 150 000 OBP – from EC
  - 275 000 Intervet
  - 350 000 OBP
- Movement control – Yes
- Desinsectisation – Yes
- Biosecurity in farms – partially presented
- Live markets measures – markets and exhibition for ruminants are closed
- Compensation schemes - Yes
- Etc



# Key challenges faced by your country and support needed

- Trade with vaccinated animals;
- Trade with meat and products from vaccinated animals;
- Disposal of carcasses – trans boundary??
- Repopulating outbreaks with new animals – how and where will vaccinate them?
- Vaccine delivery – tender procedures
- Outbreaks after vaccination – how to distinguish and can avoid stamping out?
- Trade between MS's with same health status?
