Specific challenges met since the LSD1?

- **Specific places of animal keeping: rural area, roads, high mountains and open space for animal pasture during summer ;**
- **In many cases distance between infected farms are 1 km and more**
- **Most outbreaks (about of 80 %) are on 1600 m and higher above sea level**
- **Small number of veterinarians (77 at total), small administrative capacity (only 6 vets in administration and 20 veterinary inspectors)**
- **Consumption of milk in protected and affected zone, specially because in our households cheese are prepared from raw milk**
- **Trade and animal moving from infected farms**
- **Bluetongue in same time appeared in Montenegro (11. August)**
- **Funds for vaccines and conduction of vaccination**
- **Funds for compensation for animal keepers**
- **Total budget for 2016 for animal health measures in Montenegro is 1.008.403,00 €**
- **Total expenditures for LSD was 1.173.142,50 €**

Specific challenges met since the LSD1?

- Emergency vaccination was finished for 15 days (1st August – 16th August) in a very difficult conditions for 93.550 cattles
- In same time we were doing on all mesuares on culling of all infected animals



Specific challenges met since the LSD1?

- Total amount culled cattle are 561.
- From 1st September we have only 7 infected cattle.
- Last case was 09.09.2016.
- *We can say that we stopped LSD in Montenegro and probably stopped spread of LSD on the new countries like Bosna and Hercegovina, Croatia and other countries.*
