<b>Epidemiological comments</b>	Total number of animal in the outbreaks were 5,000 susceptible, 50 cases and 50 deaths (20 ducks and 30 chickens).  Total depopulation of all infected and in-contact birds in Juba town;	<b>Source of Infection</b>	• Unknown or inconclusive
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Total ban of movement of live birds and poultry meat from Juba town to other areas and counties in southern Sudan.

The disease is now confined to Khartoum, Gezira, River Nile and Central Equatoria States.
