<p>- Pre-emptive culling of the remaining birds in the flock took place on 7 June 2006, before the results of the test were known, and was followed by the cleaning and disinfection of the holding.</p> <p>- Samples were sent to the OIE/FAO Reference Laboratory for avian influenza in Weybridge, United Kingdom, for further tests.</p> <p>- Protection and surveillance zones were established.</p> <p>- Measures laid down in the relevant European Union legislation (Council Directive 92/40/EEC, Commission Decisions 2005/734/EC and 2006/135/EC) are in place.</p>
