#### **Epidemiological comments**

- Pre-emptive culling of the remaining birds in the flock took place on 7 June 2006, before the results of the test were known, and was followed by the cleaning and disinfection of the holding.
- Samples were sent to the OIE/FAO Reference Laboratory for avian influenza in Weybridge, United Kingdom, for further tests.
- Protection and surveillance zones were established.
- Measures laid down in the relevant European Union legislation (Council Directive 92/40/EEC, Commission Decisions 2005/734/EC and 2006/135/EC) are in place.
