#### DERMATOPHILOSIS IN CHILE

**Additional information (see *Disease Information*, 6 [15], 60)**

*Translation of the text of a fax received on 30 April 1993 from Dr C. Valdovinos Jeldes, Director, Livestock Protection Division, Ministry of Agriculture, Santiago:*

*Estimated date of first infection:* February 1993.

*Number of separate outbreaks identified so far:* one (1).

*Geographical identification of the new outbreak:* Los Boldos, Santa Cruz province, O'Higgins region.

*Comments concerning affected population:* the disease occurred in fattening livestock in a closed circuit farm, comprising calves housed in stalls and adult cattle kept in the open air. Only three animals, calves of between 6 and 8 months, presented lesions.

*Comments to date concerning epidemiology of the disease:* origin unknown. The disease occurred in a farm which, for a period of about six months, had been poorly maintained both in terms of animal feed and health care, and followed a period of very heavy rainfall.

*Control measures taken during report period:* slaughter and destruction of affected animals; clinical examination and pour-on treatment of the remainder of the herd; disinsectisation of the premises; health education.
